Mr. Andrew Chapman Lane, age 78, of Road Ridge in Raven, Virginia passed away Tuesday, August 15, 2006 at the home of his daughter following a lengthy illness. He was a lifelong resident of Tazewell County and was the son of the late James Basil and Eva Hurt Lane. He served his country while enlisted in the United States Army during the Korean conflict, 1948-1952, and also enlisted with the US Army National Guard in 1964. He had been a truck driver, having hauled coal and also working for Prestige Ford before his retirement. He was a member of Road Ridge Assembly of God Church. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by 9 of his brothers and 2 sisters.
