



## Balford Stevenson,

November 21, 1913 - January 13, 2007

Balford M. Stevenson, Sr., 93, of Bowie, Maryland, formerly of Roanoke and Arlington, Virginia, passed away Saturday, January 13, 2007 at the home of his daughter following a brief illness.
