



Bernard Nearhood

April 29, 1913 - April 17, 2009

Mr. Bernard P. Nearhood, age 95, of Cedar Bluff, Virginia, passed away Friday, April 17, 2009 at his home following a lengthy illness. He was born in Davis, West Virginia and was the son of the late William Ralph and Fannie Mae Miller Nearhood. He had made his home in the Cedar Bluff area most of his life and was a retired foreman for Barnett and Cyphers, Inc. In the early 1940s, he was the postmaster and ran the movie projector for the Jewell Ridge community. He was a member of the Cedar Bluff United Methodist Church and was a 60 year member of the Cedar Bluff Masonic Lodge #260 AF & AM. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Beulah E. Fuller Nearhood and one step Great Grandson, Adam B. Taylor; one sister, Olive Smith; and three brothers, Clinton, Harry, and James Nearhood. He was the last surviving member of his immediate family. Survivors are: Two Sons: William R.
