Betty Lee Underwood Cline, age 46, of Pounding Mill, VA passed away Monday, April 5, 2010 at a Richlands, VA hospital following a long courageous battle with cancer. Betty was born in Bluefield, WV on July 30, 1963 and was a daughter of Phyllis Ann Jackson Underwood of Bluefield, WV and the late Richard Donald Underwood, Sr. Mrs. Cline had made her home in the Pounding Mill area for the past 25 years. She was a graduate of Bluefield High School, Class of 1981 and Bluefield State College, Class of 1984. Mrs. Cline was the owner and operator of Crouse Real Estate in Tazewell, VA. She was a member of Fincastle Baptist Church in Tazewell, VA. She was very active in her community, loved spending time with her family, her husband, three sons, traveling, and her church. In addition to her father, she was preceded in death by two sisters, Ellen Faye Whistlehunt and Charlotte Ann Parker; an infant brother, Joseph Underwood.
