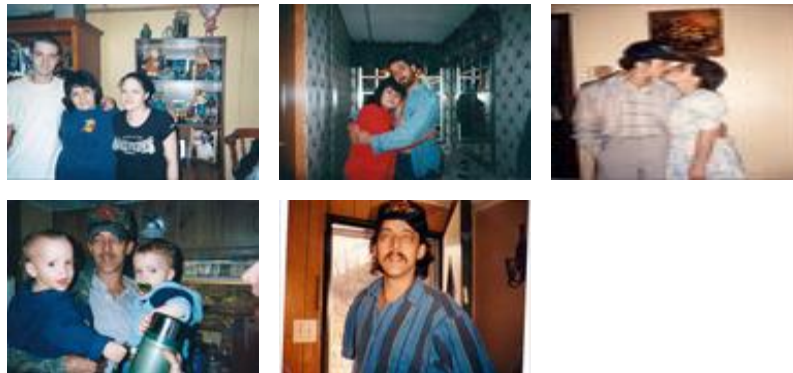

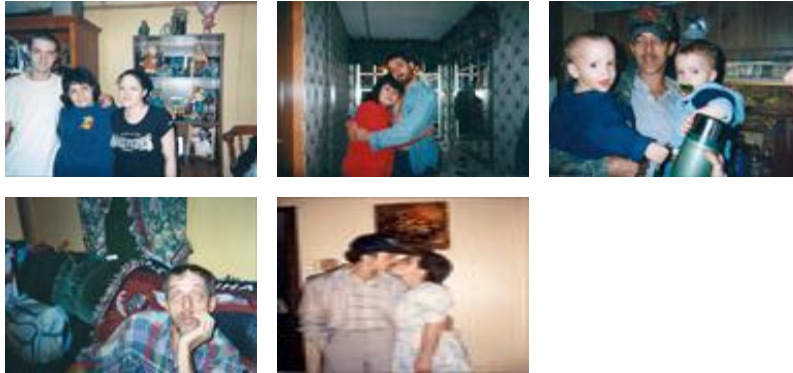

Whether it be cancer or a ticket from a game warden for not having your hunting license readily available - it amounted to the same - it was a test from God. His presence at the Body Shop was so well-timed. He would always be there when he was needed the most - not necessarily to work - but to be the moral supporter he always was. You were blessed to have him in your corner. He was a wonderful cheerleader for any cause he believed in. Bobby was a very special person who shared whatever with whomever whenever. He was never a selfish person and would offer his last cup of coffee to a complete stranger. He was a



*blessing to our family, and he will be greatly missed. As a member of the Class of '78, he brought joy, laughter, smiles, and compassion to all who knew him. Rest well, my dear friend! Your journey here is over, but your new life is just beginning! Thanks to your family for sharing you so freely with all of us! You will be missed - but you will live on in the eyes of those beautiful grandbabies. You walk with the angels now, my dear friend, and your steps will not be tiring.
