



## Brady Bucklen

December 24, 1938 - February 15, 2007

Brady Clayton Bucklen, 68, of Doran, Virginia, passed away Thursday, February 15, 2007 at Bristol Regional Hospital. He was born in Richlands, Virginia and was the son of the late Dailey McDonald Bucklen and Grace Shortt Bucklen Lawson, both Buchanan County natives.
