Brady Hess, age 97, of Richlands, Virginia, formerly of Rowe, Virginia, was called to his heavenly home on Sunday, February 27, 2022 following a lengthy illness, at the home of his daughter, Barbara McGraw.

He was born in Skeggs, Virginia on November 3, 1924 and was the son of the late Fullen and Alice Street Hess.
