



## Carl McGlothlin

December 29, 1923 - January 11, 2013

Carl McGlothlin, age 89, of Richlands, Virginia, beloved husband of Reba (White) McGlothlin, passed away peacefully on Friday, January 11, 2013, at his home surrounded by his loving family members, following a brief illness. He was born in the Page area of Garden Creek, Virginia on December 29, 1923 to the late Linkous Howard and Della Ellis McGlothlin. Carl had lived most of his life in the Richlands area. He worked for Jewell Ridge Coal Corporation for 42 years before retiring.

Carl was an incredibly talented man and an inspiration to all who knew him. He served his country in the U.S. Army and was a World War II veteran, having fought in five major battles including the Battle of the Bulge, Normandy, Northern France, Ardennes and Rhineland. He was a devoted member of the Casey-Shortt Veterans of Foreign War Post # 9640.

Carl was a founding member of the First Apostolic Church of Jesus Christ in Richlands. He most currently was a member and senior deacon of the Fountain of Joy Church in Pounding Mill. He especially loved singing in the choir and playing his mandolin. Carl's hand-crafted picture frames appear in many homes and businesses throughout the region. He was an avid archer, hunter and fisherman.
