



## Carmel (C.M.) Price

October 22, 1919 - October 9, 2008

Mr. Carmel Meredith (C.M.) Price, age 88, of Doran, Virginia passed away Thursday, October 9, 2008 at his home surrounded by his family following a lengthy illness. He was born in Ridgeview, West Virginia and was the son of the late Preston M. and Clara Estep Price. He had made his home in the Doran area since 1946 and was a retired Foreman and Electrician from Consol, Inc. He began his career in the mining industry as a coal operator of the Price Brothers Coal Company. In 1948, he and his brother, Rev. E.C. Price, established the Doran Wesleyan Church. He was involved in numerous activities for the church including being a Sunday School Teacher for over 67 years, a ministry in music, and attending district, regional, and national conferences in the Pilgrim Holiness, Wesleyan, and Methodist Churches. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Richlands, Virginia where he was a teacher for the Seekers Sunday School Class. He was a member and past president of the Tazewell West Camp of Gideon International. He was a member of UMWA Local #6025 Bishop, Virginia and was a U.S. Army World War II Veteran. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one daughter, Anita Price Butcher; Three sons, Carroll Eugene Price, Claude Marvin Price, and Carmel Meredith Price, II; One Sister, Jewell Hurst; and Two Brothers, Rev.
