Carol Lee Farley, age 57, of Raven, Virginia, passed away Saturday, May 9, 2009 in a Johnson City, Tennessee hospital. She was born in Richlands, Virginia and was the daughter of Pauline Green Plaster of Raven, Virginia and the late Jennings Plaster. She had made her home in the Knoxville, Tennessee area for the past five years and was a former Nuclear Medicine Technologist for the Thompson Cancer Survivor Center in Knoxville, TN. She was a former employee of the Clinch Valley Medical Center and the Mattie Williams Hospital. She was a Richlands High School Class of 1970 graduate, a graduate of SVCC, and received her degree in Nuclear Medicine from the University of Virginia in August of 1994. She was a member of Clearview United Methodist Church and was a member of the Richlands Order of the Eastern Star Chapter #104.
