February 5, 1933 - January 5, 2024

Rev. Carter Wells, age 90, of Bluefield, Virginia, formerly of Bristol, Virginia, passed away Friday, January 5, 2024 in a Johnson City, Tennessee hospital just one month away from his 91st birthday.

He was born in Raven, Virginia and was the son of the late William E. Wells and Maude Boyd Wells.

He had been a minister for over 63 years and was well known throughout the area. He was a Richlands High School Class of 1951 graduate.

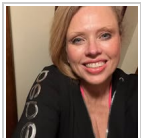

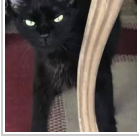
