Mr. Charles Monroe 'Casey' (Holcomb) Baker, age 62 , of North Tazewell, Virginia died Sunday, January 11, 2004 at a Richlands, Virginia hospital following a lengthy illness. He was born in McDowell County, West Virginia and was a son of the late Rev. Frank Holcomb and Mary Magdalena Hicks Holcomb, both McDowell County, West Virginia natives. He had made his home in North Tazewell for the past 2 years, but had lived most of his life in McDowell County, West Virginia. He had attended the Big Creek High School at War, West Virginia, and he was a retired coal miner and carpenter. He was a disabled Vietnam Veteran, he had served 3 tours in the Army during the Vietnam Conflict, and he had been stationed at the Berlin Wall and Okinawa. Casey was a member of the American Legion Post 175 of Bradshaw, West Virginia and the Barns- Beavers VFW Post 7136 of Tazewell, Virginia. He was a member of the Living Spring Pentecostal Holiness Church of North Tazewell, Virginia.
