Chase Brandon Stilwell, 19, of Richlands, Virginia passed away Sunday, June 15, 2008. He was born in Richlands, Virginia and was the son of Jerry and Iris Walls Stilwell, of Richlands, Virginia. He was a Richlands High School Class of 2006 Graduate, where he was member of the RHS Marching Band, and was a student at Southwest Virginia Community College. Chase was employed at Cuz's Uptown Bar-B-Q as an apprentice chef. He was gentle and kind, talented and hard-working. A dear member of the Cuz's family, "our best buddy", he was a rising star, a true "Top Chef" and he will be missed there, deeply and daily. Chase was a member of Gethsemane Baptist Church in Richlands. He was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, Harlan and Anne Walls, and paternal grandparents, Tom and Veanie Stilwell. Those who survive him, in addition to his parents, are Sister Annalise Stilwell of the home. Several Aunts, Uncles, and Cousins also survive.
