Christopher James Tague, age 38, of Pounding Mill, Virginia, passed away on Sunday, July 3, 2016 in a Bristol, Tennessee hospital following a brief illness.

He was born in Fairfax, Virginia and was the son of Dennis Ray and Monica Gilbert Tague. He was a 1995 graduate of Richlands High School and a graduate from Southwest Virginia Community College. He served his country in the United States Army. Christopher was a gifted carpenter, he designed and built cabinets, tables and other fine pieces of furniture. Christopher was also a talented musician, he started out in the Richlands High School Marching and Honor Band and went on to become an accomplished classical pianist.
