



Clyde Fred "Mac" McAllister

February 12, 1923 - June 11, 2019

Clyde Fred "Mac" McAllister, age 96 of Tazewell, VA died Tuesday, June 11, 2019 at his home. He was born February 12, 1923 at Albemarle County, VA and was a son of the late Richard Harrison McAllister and Lillie Austin Garrison McAllister. Mr. McAllister was a 1942 Graduate of McIntyre High School and had worked most of his life as a self employed contractor, specializing in landscaping and fencing. Clyde was a United States Navy Veteran serving in World War II and Korea. He was a member of the Mount Moriah United Methodist Church in Crozet, VA where he taught Sunday school and was active in the Church's men's group; he attended Harvest Outreach Ministries in Richlands, VA. Clyde was an avid gardener and his friendly smile and humble demeanor will be greatly missed.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Lena Carolyn Wise McAllister; one daughter, Judy Elizabeth Williamson; two step-sons, Don and Bobby Burke; five sisters; seven brothers. He was the last surviving member of his immediate family.

Those who survive to cherish his memory include one daughter, Patricia Ann Hurt and husband, Jim of Bristol, TN; one son, Clyde Stephen McAllister and wife, Vickie of Coffeerville, TN; three step-daughters, Anne Hickman and husband, Michael of Tazewell, VA with whom he made his home; Linda Lasley of Glasgow, VA and Lou Pough and husband, Bruce of Charlottesville, VA; one step-son, Michael Burke of Staunton, VA; seventeen grandchildren; numerous great-grand and great-great grandchildren; a host of nieces,

nephews, other family members and friends also survive.

Graveside Services for Mr. McAllister will be conducted at 1:00 p.m. Friday, June 14, 2019 at the Southwest Virginia Veteran's Cemetery in Dublin, VA with Pastors Dickey Plaster and Chris White officiating. There will be no visitation prior to the graveside services.
