Clyde Alex Witt, age 93 of the Witten Valley community of Tazewell, VA died Wednesday, July 1, 2009 at Carilion Tazewell Community Hospital. Born May 21, 1916 at Pisgah, VA he was a son of the late Charles C. Witt, Sr. and Josephine Boothe Witt. Mr. Witt was a retired coal miner having worked thirty-six years for Consolidated Coal Company at Bishop, VA. He was a member of the UMWA Local # 6025 at Bishop, VA where he received a fifty-year membership pin. Mr. Witt was a faithful member of the Maxwell First Church of God, where he was distinguished as the oldest member, and had served as Chairman on the board of trustees for many years.
