Mr. Curtis O. "Smokey" Sims, age 70 of 2030 Wardell Rd. Cedar Bluff, Virginia died Friday, December 12, 2003 at a Richlands, Virginia hospital following a lengthy illness. He was born in Dermott, Arkansas and was a son of the late Harvey Preston and Eula Maude Ringo Sams, both Arkansas natives. He had made his home in the Arkansas area most of his life, moving to Cedar Bluff thirteen years ago, retiring from the Keen Mt. Correctional Center in 1996. He served and retired as a Gunnery Sgt. with the U. S. Marine Corp. in 1949-1970 serving during both the Korean and Vietnam Wars and was awarded the Bronze Star and three Purple Hearts. He was a member of the American Legion and the Casey-Shortt VFW Post #9640 of Richlands, Virginia and the Disabled American Veterans Tazewell County Chapter #31, and the N. R. A. Mr. Sims was the last surviving member of his immediate family.
