Darlene Francis Gills, age 47 of North Tazewell, VA went to be with her Lord and Savior on Monday, September 16, 2013 while a patient at Princeton Community Hospital in Princeton, WV; she was surrounded by her loved ones as she passed from life temporal to life eternal. She was born May 13, 1966 at Cleveland, OH and was a daughter of the late Dennis William and Charlene Kommersmith Gills. Darlene was a 1984 Graduate of Tazewell High School and was a certified LPN having worked for Bland County Nursing and Rehab. She had been previously employed at Princeton Community Hospital for over twenty years and had worked at other health care facilities. Darlene was a loving and caring person who always placed the care of others above her own personal needs. She loved her profession and considered it more than just a job; she touched the lives of many people in her forty-seven years: patients and their families, co-workers, students, and the people she met in her everyday life and she was always good for a laugh. She was very proud to be co-chairperson of the Relay for Life / American Cancer Society. She was a member of St. Theresa's Catholic Church and will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved her.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by a baby brother, Daniel Paul Gills.

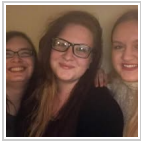

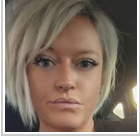
