Devon Lamar Johnson, age 25, of Charlotte, North Carolina, passed away Tuesday, November 6, 2018 in Bluefield, West Virginia.

He was born in Mercer County and was the son of Brenda Griffith Johnson of Princeton, West Virginia and the late Albert Johnson.

Devon was a former professional football player having signed with the Carolina Panthers. He played high school football at Richlands High School Class of 2012 and went on to play four years at Marshall University graduating in 2016. In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, Meriland and Mae Griffith and his paternal grandparents, Hayborn and Gladys Johnson.

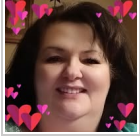
