Mr. Ernest Oscar Roisch, Sr., age 89 of Steelesburg, Virginia, passed away Thursday, April 24, 2008 in a local Tazewell, Virginia hospital.

He was born in Yukon, West Virginia and was the son of the late Karl and Sarah Hackney Roisch, former West Virginia natives.
