George T. Harrison, age 85, of Rosedale, Virginia, passed away Tuesday, December 28, 2021, in a Lebanon, Virginia hospital.

He was born September 7, 1936 in Clifffield, Virginia and was the son of the late James Bandy and Eliza May Turner Harrison. He was born and raised in Clifffield and made his home in the Baptist Valley area all of his life except for 6 years in Kentucky and currently now in Rosedale.

He was of the Methodist faith. He loved God, his church family, and gospel bluegrass music and attended Dailey's Chapel Church in Baptist Valley. He was a 1954 graduate of Tazewell High School and then proudly served in the U.S. Army for three years and took basic training at Ft. Jackson, South Carolina and was then stationed at Waldorf, Maryland with a rank of SP2. He then went on to work in surface mining as a heavy equipment operator. He owned and operated the Valley Mart convenience store in Baptist Valley for four years while working for the Hurst-Scott Funeral Home in Tazewell and Richlands for over 25 years. He was a jack of all trades, a former Mason, and he could do anything he set his mind to doing. He loved farming in his earlier years and in his spare time he enjoyed mowing grass with his John Deere. He also loved watching Wheel of Fortune, Jeopardy, and the Andy Griffith Show. He will be missed by all who knew and loved him.
