Mrs. Georgia J. Pyott, age 95 of Tazewell, VA passed away on Tuesday, December 30, 2008 at the Bristol Regional Medical Center in Bristol, TN. Born May 3, 1913 at Byllesby, VA she was a daughter of the late Willie Andrew Johnson and Birdie Elizabeth Poole Johnson.
