April 15, 1941 - December 19, 2020

Ginger Rita White Mustard, age 79, of Tazewell, Virginia, passed away at her home in Thompson Valley, Virginia, surrounded by her loving family on December 19, 2020.

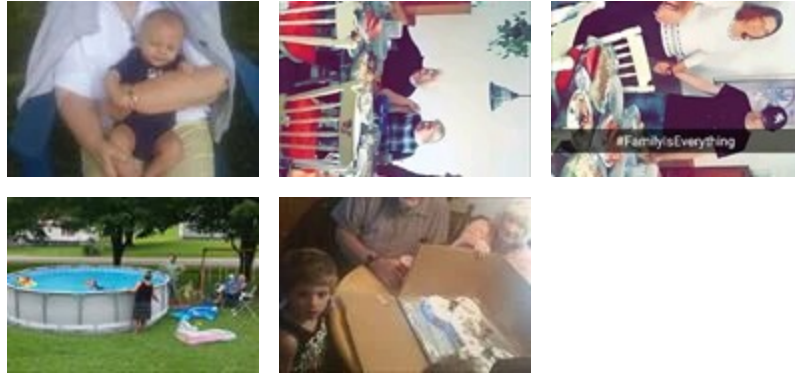
