Gladys Blanche Salyers, age 88, of Raven, VA went to be with the Lord Wednesday, August 20, 2008, in a Richlands hospital after a long illness. She was born at Red Ash, VA and moved to her current residence on Road Ridge at the age of two and resided there the remainder of her life. She was the daughter of Rev. Charlie H. and Susie Ellen White Green. She was a member of the Road Ridge Assembly of God Church. During the 1940s and 1950s, she traveled to area churches singing with the Road Ridge Quartet.
