



Glen H. Hagy

December 31, 1925 - October 6, 2020

Glen H. Hagy, 94 year old World War II Veteran, flew his last mission October 6, 2020 to be with his Lord and Savior.

Glen was born December 31, 1925 in Gary, WV to the late George William and Carrie Watson Hagy. He attended Tazewell County schools graduating from Richlands High School. In 1943, Glen enlisted in the US Air Force and completed Gunner School and was assigned to the 13th Air Force in the South Pacific. He was also in New Guinea and flew support for the liberation of the Philippines. After completing 50 missions, he was allowed to return to the states. He was promoted to Staff Sergeant and presented with an Air Medal with 3 Oak Leaf Clusters and 5 Battle Stars. Glen served his country with pride but was anxious to get back to his home in the mountains.

After returning from the war, he married Nancy Goodwin Hagy and they started their family: Daughter, Beth, and two sons: Jeff and Matthew. He continued his education and received his Bachelor's Degree at Concord College in June 1950. He then graduated from the University of Virginia and received his Masters Degree in 1956.

Glen devoted much of his life to education where he taught school and was a football coach. He touched many young men's lives. Glen later accepted a job with VA State Rehabilitation Service and worked there until he retired. He said

retirement was made for him. Glen was active in the community and served as Councilman and Vice Mayor for the Town of Cedar Bluff for many years. Glen was an active member of the Claypool Hill Church of Christ and served as an elder until his health forced him to resign.

Glen was a devoted father, husband, grandfather, and dear friend. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his first wife, Nancy Goodwin Hagy; brother, Tom Hagy; and sisters, Ruth Hagy and Billie Thompson.

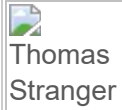
