



## Granville Tjaden

August 18, 1931 - August 10, 2008

Granville Allen Tjaden, age 76 of Raven, Virginia, formerly of Delaware, went to be with the Lord Sunday morning, August 10, 2008 at his home surrounded by his loving family, following a lengthy illness. He was born in East New Market, Maryland and was the son of the late Hiram Tjaden, Sr. and Jeanette Bush Tjaden, former Delaware natives. Granville bravely served his country in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean War.
