Harold James Steffey, Jr., of Cedar Bluff, Virginia, passed away on Monday, March 24, 2025.

Harold was born on October 16, 1948, in Castlewood, Virginia, and was the son of the late Harold J. Steffey, Sr. and Lutie Alice Bailey Steffey. Harold Steffey entered the U.S. Army in 1969 and was stationed in Vietnam by July of that year. He served in the 4th Infantry Division as an M-60 Machine Gunner in the Central Highlands of Vietnam and received many medals for his valor and bravery. He was honorably discharged on February 1st, 1975. Afterwards, he worked for various coal companies for 34 years.

Harold was of the Christian faith, who for a number of years, served in several different roles in Layman's Chapel Church of Richlands, inspiring many and leaving a rich deposit of precious memories in the memory banks of those who knew him.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a younger sister, Mary Steffey.

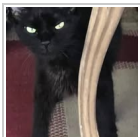
