After 51 years always by each other's side, only separated by 52 days, Jack Donaldson "Don" Dean completed his "ultimate round" on Wednesday, September 29, 2021 to be back with his loving wife. He was surrounded by his children, looking out at his beloved lake from his home in Dandridge TN. After suffering over 40 years with chronic pain as a result of his mining accident in 1980, he is now pain free, celebrating in Heaven with our sweet Mom. He could always be found spending time mowing his yard, playing golf, and making bets with his friends.

He was born in Clifffield, VA, on July 15, 1951 and had an art for always bringing a smile to your face with his awkward acquired sense of humor. Don always worked ridiculously hard to provide for his family. He started his working career at Western Auto, moving on to dedicating 15 years at Consolidated Coal, and finally to owning and managing Wolf Creek Golf and Country Club for 25 years. Don worked hard to achieve his Golf Course Superintendents certifications. The years spent at Wolf Creek shaped our lives for many years where we met many friends, we now consider family. Don was a 1971 Graduate of Tazewell High School.

In 2011, Don dedicated his life to serving The Lord, and witnessing in his own unique way to spread the word. Our parents cited Ruth 1:16-17, in their wedding vow and their vow renewal and this echoes throughout their lives. 16 But Ruth replied, "Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from you.
