James Leroy Payne, Sr., age 66 of Bluefield, VA, passed away Wednesday, April 7, 2010 at his home, following a lengthy, courageous battle with cancer. He was born July 6, 1943 in Grundy, VA and was a son of the late Alex and Susie Blankenship Payne. Mr. Payne had worked for Rish Equipment Company from 1965 to 1974, and Morris and Marshall Coal Company from 1974 – 1983. In 1983 James and his wife, Ruth started their family business, Payne Equipment Corp. and in 1994 James, and his wife, Ruth along with their sons started Payne Industrial and Farm Equipment Inc. In 1990 James realized a long time dream of having a farm and both his family business and farm are still in operation today. Mr. Payne was a member of Mt.
