Mr. Jesse Wallace Jackson, age 81, of Cedar Bluff, Virginia, passed away Friday, June 04, 2010 in a Roanoke, Virginia hospital following a brief illness. He was born in Whitewood, Virginia and was the son of the late Ingrahm Marion and Rosa Dale Atwell Jackson. He had made his home in the Cedar Bluff area most of his life and was retired from the Maintenance Department of the Tazewell County School System. He was the last surviving member of his immediate family.
