Jimmie Allen Crouse, age 74 of Marion, VA, formerly of Cedar Bluff, VA died Saturday, May 23, 2009 at Smyth County Hospital in Marion, VA. Born October 18, 1934 at Bishop, VA he was a son of the late Lindsay Gray "Slick" and Ruth Ann Shrader Crouse. He was employed as a Quality Control Inspector with the Brunswick Corporation in Marion, VA and was a former employee of the S & S Corporation at Claypool Hill, VA and Titan Wheel in Saltville, VA.
