Jimmie Jackson, Sr., age 89, of Raven, VA, left this world and entered into the presence of his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, January 27, 2026 in Monroe, GA.

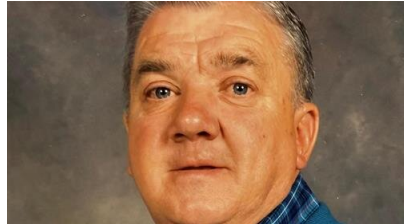

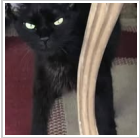
