Jimmy Darrell McReynolds, age 71, of Cedar Bluff, Virginia, died Friday, February 5, 2010 at his home. He was born June 19, 1938 at Tazewell County, Virginia and was a son of Blanche Patterson McReynolds of Dix Creek, Virginia and the late Melvin McReynolds. Mr. McReynolds was a 1956 graduate of Tazewell High School. He was a retired United States Navy Veteran, having served honorably in the Vietnam War. During his twenty years of service Mr. McReynolds received the Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, the MUC award, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal (Dominican Republic), Navy Commendation Medal, and the Navy Achievement Medal. He was a member of the American Legion. Upon retiring from the Navy Mr. McReynolds continued to serve his community as a police officer, retiring from the Town of Tazewell Police Department. He had also worked for the Richlands Police Department and the Tazewell County Sheriff's Department. He was a member of the Lake Witten Worship Center in Tazewell, VA.
