Jimmy Ray Osborne, age 84 of Baptist Valley, VA died Tuesday, October 26, 2021 at Clinch Valley Medical Center in Richlands, VA. He was born June 8, 1937 in Marion, VA and was a son of the late Fred and Nancy Ellen Hayden Osborne. Jimmy was a United States Air Force Veteran and was proud to have served his country. He had a diverse career, as a teen he helped his father on the farm, plowing with horses. He had owned a service station and was a skilled craftsman in drywall installation and finishing, carpentry and other building trades. He loved spending time with his family, gardening, landscaping, fishing, and just being outdoors. He was of the Baptist faith and often said he was blessed every day.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Linda Parsons Osborne; one brother, Fred David Osborne.
