Joanne V. Boys, age 94, of Mt. Juliet, TN, formerly of Richlands, VA passed away on Tuesday, April 21, 2020 at her daughter's home in TN.

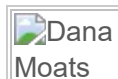

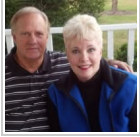
