Johnathen "Johnny" Wayne Knuckles age 52 of Mt. Airy, North Carolina, formerly of Richlands, passed away on Monday, March 9, 2020 at his home in Mt. Airy.

He was born in Cleveland, Ohio and was the son of Christella "Stella" Hess Knuckles Richardson of Raven, Virginia and the late Dewey Rayborn Knuckles. Johnny was a graduate of Richlands High School Class of 1987 and went on to serve his country in the U.S. Army. He later worked for L.S. Starrett as a machinist for several years. 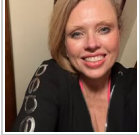
