Mr. Joseph Allen Addison, age 20, of 122 Parkway St. Cedar Bluff, Virginia, died Saturday, April 3rd, 2004 at the University of Virginia Hospital in Charlottesville, Virginia following a brief illness. He was a life long resident of the Cedar Bluff area and was a 2001 graduate of Richlands High School.
