December 25, 1920 - September 23, 2007

Mr. Joseph Burge, age 87 of Richlands, Virginia passed away at his home surrounded by his loving family, Sunday September 23, 2007, following a lengthy illness. He was born in Kentucky and was the son of the late Johnie and Katie Hunter Burge. He had served his country during World War II, and after his discharge he became a buyer manager for a large corporate grocery store for many years. Later on in life he became a farmer and enjoyed working the land and tending his livestock. He was a member of the New Hope Assembly of God church at Claypool Hill and was the last surviving member of his family. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his brother Michael Burge who was killed during World War II and his Aunt Minnie Greene who raised him since he was four years old after his mother died. Surviving him is his loving wife, Edith Burge of Richlands, Virginia. Many friends and loved ones also survive him. Funeral services for Mr. Joseph Burge will be conducted at 2:00 pm on Wednesday, September 26, 2007 at Hurst-Scott Funeral Home in Richlands, Virginia with the Rev. Claudie Throgmartin and Rev.
