Juanita Carroll Price, age 92, of the Doran Bottom section of Raven, Virginia, passed away Saturday, October 15, 2016 at her home.

She was born in Wolfpit, KY and was the daughter of the late George and Lula Horn Carroll.

She had made her home in the Raven area most of her life and was a former cafeteria manager for Tazewell County Public School System. She was an active member of the First United Methodist Church in Richlands, Virginia where she was involved in teaching Sunday School, a member of the choir, and was a member of the United Methodist Women.
