Lindsey Walter Harman, age 85, of North Tazewell, Virginia, passed away on Thursday, October 20, 2022, at Clinch Valley Medical Center following a brief illness.

Lindsey was born on April 9, 1937 in Tazewell County and was the son of the late Brown “Cowboy” Harman and Catherine “Kate” McGuire Harman. He grew up on a farm in the Goose Creek/Whitley Branch area where he started working on the farm at age 5, helping in the fields.
