



## Lois Henderson

October 8, 1920 - January 26, 2004

Mrs. Lois Hillman Henderson, age 83, of Charlotte, North Carolina formerly of Richlands, Virginia died Monday, January 26th, 2004 at the Laurels at Highland Creek in Charlotte, North Carolina. She was the daughter of the late Joseph C. and Elsie T. Owens Hillman of Finney and later Honaker, Virginia. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Dr. Walter Tillou Henderson and two brothers, Miles and Bud Hillman. Lois was a 1936 graduate of Honaker High School, attended Emory & Henry from 1936 to 1938 and Graduated Cum Laude from St. Luke's Hospital school of nursing in Bluefield, West Virginia on October 28, 1941. She attended the University of Virginia for a brief internship in teaching methods and became director of nursing at St. Luke's. Lois joined the United States Army in April of 1943, and was commissioned as a Lieutenant and served as a nurse in Ora Bay, New Guinea and later in Manila in the Philippines where she remained until the end of the war. She was also a member of the Richlands Presbyterian Church.
