Lucille Hollenhead, age 95, of Richlands, Virginia, passed to her heavenly home on February 16, 2024.

Lucille was born in Knoxville, Tennessee on December 31, 1928. She lived in Knoxville most of her childhood. Beginning in 1947, she attended King College in Bristol, Tennessee, where she met J.B., her husband of 51 years. Lucille and J.B. married in December of 1950 and over the next 17 years, had four daughters and one son. In 1961, Lucille and J.B. left their home in Knoxville and moved to Richlands. Lucille was a devoted wife and mother. Once all five children were in school, Lucille took a job as a teacher's aide at Richlands Elementary School, where she enjoyed helping children with math and other academics and began new friendships that would last a lifetime. She retired in 2001 after 28 years of service.

A member of the Richlands Presbyterian Church since 1961, Lucille was a dedicated worker in the church. Over the years, she taught Sunday School, helped with various youth programs, chaired the Mission Committee and Congregational Care and Concern Committee, presided at both President and Vice President of the Women of the Church, served as a ruling elder, and served as a representative to Presbytery. She was awarded an Honorary Life Membership for faithful service to women's work in the church. Most recently, she focused on the Operation Christmas Child shoebox mission, wrapping

nearly 1000 boxes each year. Lucille loved her church family, particularly her Sunday School Class and her Women's Circle which she hosted once a month in her home.

Lucille was always busy around the house, enjoying sewing, vegetable and flower gardening, working jigsaw puzzles, and hosting family during the holidays.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Mac Albert Campbell and Mary Ruth Logan Campbell; her husband, Rev. James B. Hollenhead; granddaughters, Jodi Beth Alderson and Natalee McCall; great granddaughter, Justace Gibson; and great grandson, Holston Cole.

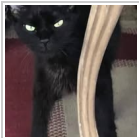
