Mabel Elizabeth Jackson age 95, of Cedar Bluff, Virginia passed away on Friday, March 15, 2024, at the Clinch Valley Medical Center in Richlands, Virginia.

Mabel was born January 1, 1929, in Richlands, Virginia, and was the daughter of the late Kelly Jackson and Mary Blevins Jackson. It is hard to truly capture the essence of a person with words, so to try and describe the type of person that Mabel was, imagine a pair of outstretched hands, that was always willing to be there in your time of need. Mabel had dedicated her life to being a nurse, she challenged herself to gain as much knowledge as possible so that she could help those in need. 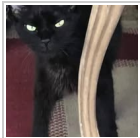
