Mrs. Madeline Groves Tizen, of Pounding Mill, Virginia, went home to be with the Lord Thursday, April 30, 2009 in a Princeton, West Virginia hospital following a brief illness. She was born in Richwood, West Virginia and was the daughter of the late Hunter and Mary Fitzwater Groves. She had made her home in the Richlands and Claypool Hill area for the past seventy years and was a retired Registered Nurse. She worked at both the Mattie Williams Hospital and the Clinch Valley Clinic Hospital. She was a graduate of Summersville High School and the Nurses Training Program at Charleston General Hospital in Charleston, West Virginia. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Richlands, Virginia where she was a member of the Asbury Sunday School Class, the Josephine White Circle, and sang in the choir. She loved game shows, working crossword puzzles, won several spelling bees at SVCC, and loved to attend the West Virginia State Fair.
