Mr. Marcus Deel, age 81, of Pounding Mill, Virginia passed away Friday, December 6, 2013 at Buchanan General Hospital in Grundy, Virginia following a lengthy illness.

He was born in Buchanan County, Virginia and was the son of the late William Burgy and Louisa Deel.
