Margaret K. Grose, age 95 of Newhall, West Virginia, passed away on December 19, 2025 in a Tazewell, Virginia nursing home, following a lengthy illness.

In quilting, she felt like she could weave her and God's love into each stitch, so when the quilt covered that person, they would feel the comforting love settle over them.
