Mary Jayne Smith, age 21 of Tazewell, VA died Sunday, March 22, 2020 at Tazewell Community Hospital in Tazewell, VA. She was born January 5, 1999 and was the daughter of Shanta Smith Jackson. Mary Jayne was a 2018 Graduate of Tazewell High School. She was a Cheerleader for the Bulldogs and in 2017 she was the first young black lady to be crowned as Homecoming Queen in the history of Tazewell High School. She was granted a wish from the “Make-A-Wish Foundation” and she chose to go to Disney World for a date with Mickey Mouse and tea with the Disney Princesses; she loved Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse. She was a member of the First Baptist New Beginning Church in Tazewell, VA; loving to sing, she was a soloist at her Church. She had a wonderful spirit and if you reminded her of a cartoon character, she would rename you.

She was preceded in death by her paternal Grandparents, Beverly “Bev” and Alice Smith; her grandmother, whom she was named after, Mary Jayne Smith; one uncle, Alvin J. Smith; one aunt, Beverly Smith.

In addition to her mother, those who survive to celebrate her memory include, her grandparents and guardians, who raised her as their own, Robert “Bobby” and Gloria Smith of Tazewell, VA; two siblings, Jewel Jackson and Jeremiah Jackson, both of Bristol, VA; special sister, Toni Jones of Las Vegas, NV; her great-grandmother, Earnestine Johnson of Sandersville, GA; special grandmother, Patricia Manns Hairston of Princeton, WV; “boyfriends” Deacon Patrick Keeter and Deputy Rommell Hargrave; several aunts and uncles; a
