January 10, 1924 - October 19, 2010

McAdoo Fletcher, age 86, of Richlands, Virginia passed away on Wednesday, October 19, 2010 following a brief illness. He was born in Tazewell, Virginia and was the son of the late William Floyd and Mary Cline Fletcher.
