Millard Kermit Farmer, age 85, of Jewell Ridge, Virginia, passed away Monday, November 15, 2010 in a Richlands, Virginia hospital following a lengthy illness. He was born in Dungannon, Virginia and was the son of the late Jonas Lee and Lou Osborne Farmer. He had made his home in the Jewell Ridge area for over 60 years and was the co-owner of Farmer Brothers Coal Company and was the outside sales clerk for Sears of Richlands for 29 years. He was a graduate of Dungannon High School Class of 1943. He was a former member of the Tazewell County Planning Commission; Cumberland Plateau and Airport Authority; Richlands Area Chamber of Commerce having served as president; and the Tazewell County IDA. He was actively involved on the Eastern Coal Council and the Jewell Ridge Recreation and Development Corporation. He was a former member of the Richlands Masonic Lodge #318 AF & AM. He was a member of the Jewell Ridge Presbyterian Church where he served as superintendent of Sunday school, Ruling Elder, and the Clerk of the Session. He was also a past moderator of the Abingdon Presbytery. He was a U.S. Navy World War II Veteran. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mozella Katherine Ratcliffe Farmer; one son, Daniel Richard Farmer; and three brothers, Arthur, Earnest, and Clarence Farmer.
