Nancy Lee King Cousins 86, formerly of Tazewell, VA died after a lengthy illness at Danville Regional Medical Center in Danville, VA on October 22, 2008. She was born on May 23, 1922 in Tazewell, VA, the daughter of the late Albert Jefferson King and Sara Rosalie Steele King. She graduated in 1940 from Graham High School in Bluefield, VA. She was married to the late James S. Cousins, Sr. on April 10, 1946. Their union lasted for fifty years. Two sons were born to this union, John William and J. Stanley Cousins, Jr. She was a resident of Philadelphia, PA for over 40 years before relocating to Virginia after retirement. She attended Pierce Business College in Philadelphia and was a former business owner, and worked in bookkeeping for several banks and insurance companies over the years. She was a member of the Easter Star, the NAACP and active in the cub scouts as a den mother and the neighborhood communities watch programs. She joined the Mt. She was a loving mother and grandmother and was lovingly cared for by her family for eleven years. She is survived by her son, Elder J. Stanley Cousins, Jr. of Ringgold, VA.
